Proposals

On Thursday, April 3rd, preceding the [2014 ASEE Zone 1 Conference](#) activities on Friday, the Conference will be conducting tutorials. We invite groups of interested researchers or educators to submit tutorial proposals.

The goal of a tutorial is to provide an informal forum for researchers or educators to discuss, present and elaborate on important and emerging areas relating to an aspect of Multidisciplinary Engineering Education and Research; and Industry Involvement in Engineering Endeavors at Institutions of Higher Education in the U.S.; which are the main themes of the Conference. Examples of potential topics for solicited tutorial proposals could include, but not limited to: Nano Engineering, Evolving Energy and Power Research, Sustainable Environments and Development, New Paradigms in Additive Manufacturing, Green Engineering and Renewable Energy, Biomedical Engineering and Biotechnology, Manufacturing Technologies, Multidisciplinary Engineering Education and Research, Space and Aeronautical Engineering and Industrial Collaborations with Engineering Schools. A tutorial is anticipated to be presented by 3-4 speakers.
